Day 1 – The safari starts in Maun the safari capital of Botswana on the edge of the famous Okavango Delta. After clearing customs and immigration formalities we then set off in our safari vehicle to the Moremi Game Reserve. The team will set up camp while we set off for an afternoon game drive – exploring this amazing spectacle of nature that teems with wildlife and the focus of many African wildlife documentaries over the years. Our camp is made up of walk in dome tents with shared facilities, mattresses on the floor work best but if you prefer a stretcher this can be provided and LED lighting. All comfortable and functional.



Day 2 – On this day we continue working through this excellent park but we shall break up the day by going on a cruise on the water exploring the numerous water channels that make up the Delta and looking for those animals, reptiles and birds that are at home in this environment including Sitatunga, Hippo, Crocodiles plus numerous frog and bird species.

Day 4 – Our camp gets taken down by the team to be reset in Khwai in an operator only campsite, Khwai borders on the Northern edge of the Moremi Game Reserve and is a community controlled area which allows us the option of doing walks and also night drives which adds a completely different perspective to our safari and a number of species that you might not normally see, like porcupines, aardvark, genets and hopefully watching some of the more nocturnal predators hunting.





Day 7 – Once again our camp is lowered and we move to our next destination in the famous Savuti Marsh area of the Chobe National Park we get there by driving along the Khwai River.. Here we will be able to explore the extensive grasslands and this game rich area often produces some surprising sightings like leopards hunting catfish in the Savuti Channel. There is lots of wildlife here and varied terrain including rocky outcrops and marshland, plenty to see which will keep our days varied finishing each day sitting around the campfire under the beautiful African night sky.



Day 10 – After breakfast we then say goodbye to our camp team and head off to the airstrip for a charter flight back to Maun so you can catch your onward flight connections.

Due to the traditional nature of this safari you shall be in open safari vehicles throughout and when moving camp this will be in a trailer behind the vehicle and we shall travel with the staff to the next campsite. This also means that space is limited and you will be asked to pack to an absolute minimum.
